- Limit of 150 words
- The contest opens on February 1st, 2017 at 10 a.m. EST and closes on March 24, 2017 at 11:59 p.m. EST.

- Each participant will be registered once for the draw and can only win one prize.
- The OLC will do a draw for an iPod, an iPad and a hoodie.
- The draw will take place on March 28, 2017 at 10 a.m. EST.
- With consent of the individuals, winner's names will be disclosed and announced to the public through various media.
- Winners have the option to receive their prize by mail or to pick it up at the OLC.
- Winning participants will have until March 31st, 2017 to provide the OLC with their mailing address, phone number and e-mail address, or to pick up their prize. Failure to do so, the OLC will draw a new winner.
